I hope everyone enjoyed the Holiday season and is doing well. Here at Top-Flight we are running and gunning, and on the final stretch. Hard to believe we only have 8 weeks left to go. As any of you know it has been a wet one. In 30 years here I do not remember ever having a season where it stayed this wet, for this long. Unfortunately we can do nothing about it but slog through and hope one day the rains come to an end.

Here on the preserve hunts are going well and at this time many of the remaining Saturdays are booking up. Birds will come down to the wire but we are going to attempt to make it to the end of March, however if you are wanting to get some hunts in do not wait to long to get it booked. At this time we are bringing birds in but once they are booked we will be done. Last load of Chukar came from Pennsylvania and Pheasants came from Kentucky. Quail are almost non existent and once we go through ours will probably not be able to get any more.

The waterfowl season was one for the record books. In 40 years of guiding waterfowl I do not think I have ever experienced one this frustrating and tough. Not many birds and way to much water on the prairie. As tough as it was we ended up averaging 3.5 birds per hunter, down from a 5 bird average last year. Hopefully next year gets back to the norm.
